#### Homeless in Santa Fe

Santa Fe hosted two roundtable discussions with hundreds of participants in the fall to address issues of housing in this city. From that effort, a spin-off is continuing to work with Anchorum and with Project Moxie to begin setting up protected groups of pallet homes. The homes are lockable tiny homes with a bed, to accommodate a person and their stuff, or pet or small family. The idea would include staff or trained volunteers onsite 24-7. A pilot project is being launched.

The state is promising to add to the funds that help, via the Linkages program.
